What moments of the day are most important to you? This will help you figure out how many hours of photography you'll need! Here's my rule of thumb:

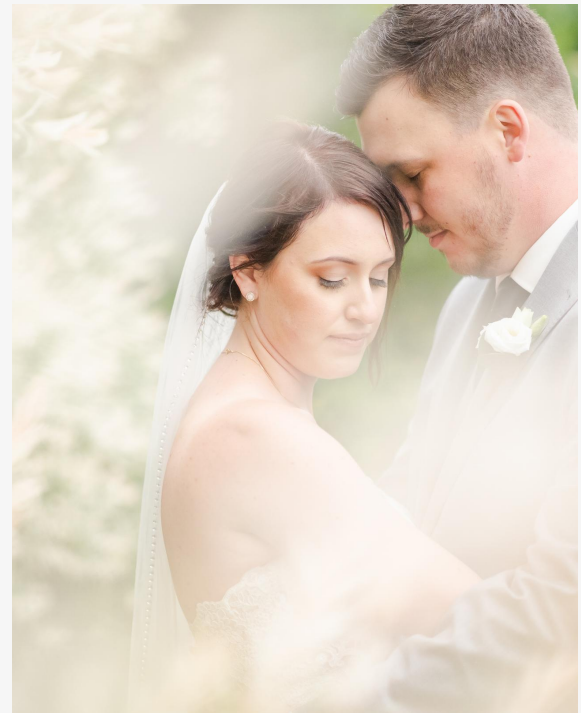
6 Hours: Ceremony > Reception

8 Hours: Bride Getting Ready > Reception

10 Hours: Bride & Groom Getting Ready > Reception
